

PRIVACY STATEMENT

DATA PROCESSING OPERATION: TIMES STAKEHOLDERS DATABASE

1. Introduction

The TIMES Project has received funding from the European Union's Horizon Europe programme under Grant Agreement n°. 101118915.

TIMES is a joint effort of scientists working at different areas of the ab initio community to drive the method developments for understanding complex nonequilibrium dynamics in quantum materials. The team involves leading scientists in the field from 7 European countries and a planned recruitment of 11 Doctoral Candidates (DC). The network is diverse both in the scientific background and in the application, including direct links between academia and cutting-edge industry, and is aimed to redefine the state-of-the-art, through a development of new ab-initio theoretical and computational tools to tackle the coherent and correlated electron-ion dynamics initiated and controlled by means of ultra-short laser pulses over timescales ranging from few hundred atto-seconds and up to nanoseconds. The Project will explore complex quantum states, time-dependent properties, and novel emergent phenomena in a diverse range of functional materials, including perovskites, 2D materials, magnetic materials, Weyl semimetals, Dirac materials, and topological insulators.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this data processing operation is the subscription to the TIMES newsletters; communication and events announcements; dissemination of TIMES activities; information about the TIMES project and its results; to promote innovation and technology transfer; to send survey forms and other communications activities.

3. Description of the data processing operation

The Personal Data is stored in a database of TIMES Consortium named "TIMES STAKEHOLDERS DATABASE".

4. Data processed

The data processed, including personal data, contain the following: complete name, country, place of work, department and position held, and e-mail address.

5. Controller of the processing operation

The UNIVERSITY OF VALENCIA (Universitat de València, UV), is the partner responsible for the management of the data processed under this operation.

6. Legal Basis

The legal basis for this data processing operation is the consent. The processing of personal data is required to contact and receive information regarding the activities developed by the TIMES Project, namely to the registration to the newsletters of the project. Therefore, not providing the required personal data or not accepting the privacy statement concerning this data processing operation will render it impossible to register, submit or receive information

regarding said activities. In accordance with the Regulation UE no. 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation), where applicable, as well as any other legislation or regulatory requirements in force from time to time which apply to each Party relating to the use of personal data, the TIMES consortium assures that the personal data obtained from your submission will be incorporated into a record, property of the TIMES Consortium, having implemented all security measures.

7. Security Measures

The TIMES Consortium shall ensure that it has in place appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect against unauthorised or unlawful processing of Personal Data and against accidental loss or destruction of, or damage to, Personal Data, appropriate to the harm that might result from the unauthorised or unlawful processing or accidental loss, destruction or damage and the nature of the data to be protected, having regard to the state of technological development and the cost of implementing any measures.

8. Recipients of the data

The TIMES Consortium will have access to the personal data, as well as the project's contractors if any and, if requested, the Program Managing Authorities (Horizon Europe).

Contractors are defined as service providers engaged by the TIMES consortium to perform specific tasks related to the execution of the TIMES Project. Contractors shall have access to personal data on a specific need-to-know basis, they shall be made aware of this privacy statement and they shall undertake obligations no less onerous than those contained in this statement.

Personal data will not be used for other purposes than those described above. Except for the situations referred to in the previous paragraphs they will not be disclosed to any third parties.

9. Legality of processing

10. Provision, access and rectification of the data
